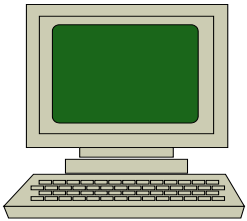
Middle School Food Drive

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF RIVER RIDGE ANNUAL NOTICE OF SPECIAL EDUCATION REFERRAL AND EVALUATION PROCEDURES

Upon request, the River Ridge School District is required to evaluate a child for eligibility for special education services. A request for evaluation is known as a referral. When the district receives a referral, the district will appoint an Individualized Education Program (IEP) team to determine if the child has a disability, and if the child needs special education services. The district locates, identifies, and evaluates all children with disabilities who are enrolled by their parents in private (including religious) schools, elementary schools and secondary schools located in the school district.

A physician, nurse, psychologist, social worker, or administrator of a social agency who reasonably believes a child brought to him or her for services is a child with a disability has a legal duty to refer the child, including a homeless child, to the school district in which the child resides. Before referring the child, the person making the referral must inform the child's parent that the referral will be made.

Others, including parents, who reasonably believe a child is a child with a disability, may also refer the child, including a homeless child, to the school district in which the child resides.

Referrals must be in writing and include the reason why the person believes the child is a child with a disability. A referral may be made by contacting Amy Jones, Pupil Services Director, River Ridge School District, at 608-994-2715, or by writing her at River Ridge School District, PO Box 78, 11165 County Road P, Patch Grove, WI 53817.

REGISTRATION FOR 2020-21 SCHOOL YEAR

The 9th-11th grade students will start registering for their 2021-22 classes the week of January 25, 2021. If any parent has a question about their son or daughter's credits or classes needed for graduation or post-secondary education plans, please contact Ms. Townsend.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT PROGRAM

As we pivot back and forth between face to face and virtual education, we recognize this can be a challenge for many students. Please realize that letter grades will be administered this school year. We will not be distributing pass/fail grades like we did last spring. We understand that many students are struggling with the virtual platform so we have services in place to support those students. If your son or daughter is struggling and you haven't already been contacted by our support team, please contact me and I would be more than happy to assist you. If your son or daughter fails a course that is required for graduation, they will be required to repeat that class next year and will need to record that on their 2020-21 course registration. If a senior fails a required course or falls below the 24 credit requirement, they will not be allowed to participate in graduation with their class or receive their diploma. Our support team is here. Please reach out and let us help you.

ACT FOR JUNIORS

All juniors will be required to take the ACT test on March 9, 2021. Because this is a mandated assessment from the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, we ask that you avoid all appointments on this date. DPI is strongly recommending that we offer the ACT and to follow all safety guidelines to do so. River Ridge is dedicated to providing a safe environment for our juniors to come to our building and complete the ACT. Our testing room will accommodate the 6 feet social distancing rule and masks will be required.

No Semester Exams for High School Student

The high school staff determined that the students will not have 1st semester exams this year. We feel with the lack of continuity it is too much to ask of our students to prepare for a semester test that is worth 20% of your grade. Therefore, each quarter will count for 50% of the semester grade.
